

M510 Label Printer Frequently Asked Questions

Create labels with desktop software or keyboard



Operating your printer

How does the M510 printer work?

The M510 Label Printer can be operated by using the keyboard or when connected to Brady Workstation software. Connect the M510 to a PC to design labels and print from Brady Workstation desktop software.

What's included with the M510 Label Printer?

The M510 comes with an AC adapter, USB cord, a 1.5" (38.1mm) All-Weather vinyl label cartridge, NiMH battery, USB flash drive with a driver and User Manual, Brady Workstation Basic label design software and a Quickstart Guide.

What's included with the M510 kit?

The M510 kit includes an AC adapter, USB cord, a 1.5" (38.1mm) All-Weather vinyl label cartridge, hard case, magnet, utility hook, NiMH battery, Li-ION battery, USB flash drive with a driver and User Manual, Brady Workstation Basic label design software and a Quickstart Guide.

What accessories are available?

Many accessories are available and can be purchased individually, including: AC adapter, hard case, NiMH battery, Li-ION battery, magnet and a utility hook.

Does the printer have Bluetooth or Wi-Fi connectivity?

No. The M510 printer does not have Bluetooth or Wi-Fi capabilities.

Does the printer have USB connectivity?

Yes. The printer can connect over USB to a laptop or a desktop computer when users want to print with Brady Workstation desktop software.

How fast does the M510 print labels?

It prints up to 1.5" (38.1mm) per second.

What is the print resolution?

The print resolution is 300 dpi.

How durable is the printer?

The M510 resists 4 ft (1.2m) drops.

What is the life of the NiMH battery?

Users can print up to 1,700 labels on a fully charged printer.

What is the life of the Li-ION battery?

Users can print up to 4,400 labels on a fully charged printer.

How do I connect the printer to Brady Workstation?

Use the USB cable to connect your printer to a computer with Brady Workstation software.

What types of labels can I create using Brady Workstation label creation software?

Use design guides to create a multitude of different labels: arc flash, asset tags, general, Lean/5S, patch panel, pipe marker, safety, terminal block or text-only.

What advanced features exist with Brady Workstation?

Advanced features include Scan and Print, Data Automation, Templates, Advanced Sequences and Advanced Data Import. Learn more at BradylD.com.au/workstation.

Label Materials

How do I know which labels I can use with the M510?

You can usee Brady Authentic labels that begin with a catalog number of M4-, M4C-, M5- or M5C-.

Can I use my BMP®51 or BMP®41 label cartridges in my M510 printer?

Legacy labels (BMP®41 and BMP®51) will not work in the M510. Only Brady Authentic labels work in the M510 printer. Look for the Authentic 'A' on packaging and the cartridge.

What type of labels are available for my M510 printer?

There are 250+ label cartridges including: All-Weather, Flag, Heat Shrink Sleeves, Laboratory, Metallised, Multi-Purpose, Tags/Inserts, Tamper Evident, Wrap Around and BradyGrip® labels.

Can I use non-Brady labels with this printer?

No. The printer requires Brady Authentic labels.

Support, Repairs and Warranty

What is the warranty period?

Your M510 Label Printer has a 2-year warranty.

How do I upgrade the printer firmware?

Upgrade printer firmware using Brady Workstation, a USB drive or a USB cord for computer connection.

What routine maintenance should be done?

Routine maintenance includes: upgrading firmware, cleaning the printer and recycling used label cartridges.
